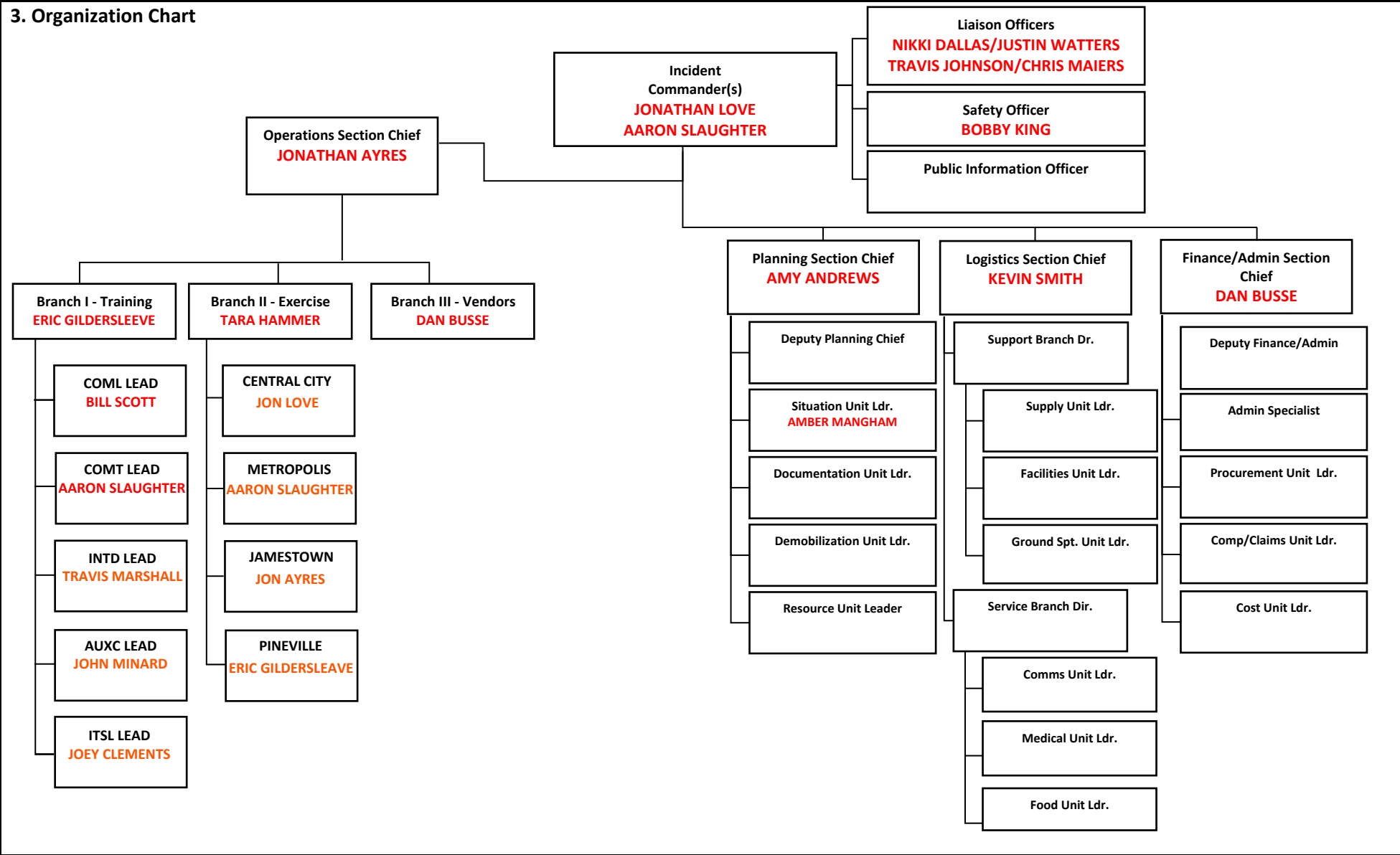

All channels are shown as if programmed into a hand held, mobile or control station radio. A Repeater must be programmed with the Rx and Tx reversed. A Base Station is simplex typically.

Safety and security of the participants and staff are a high priority at the Red River COMU Bootcamp.

SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Maintain situational awareness at all times.
- Be aware of your surroundings and report any suspicious activity.
- Use the buddy system whenever possible, especially during nighttime or remote exercises.
- Stay weather aware. Be prepared for changing weather conditions.
- Secure all tents, antenna masts, and temporary structures in case of high winds or storms.

VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC SAFETY

- Maintain safe speeds and follow all posted signage.
- Watch for vehicles not watching for you.
- Do not block emergency access routes or fire lanes.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- Wear appropriate PPE as required (e.g., gloves, eye protection, safety vests).
- If working in noisy environments, use hearing protection.

HYDRATION AND ILLNESS PREVENTION

- Stay hydrated. Drink water regularly.
- Watch for signs of heat stress (dizziness, fatigue, confusion).
- Sanitize shared equipment between uses.

POWER AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT SAFETY

- Avoid overloading power strips and circuits.
- Keep liquids away from electrical equipment.
- Watch for possible slips, trips and falls due to extended power cords or other equipment.
- Use proper lifting techniques when moving equipment or cases. Use team lifts for heavy loads.

RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

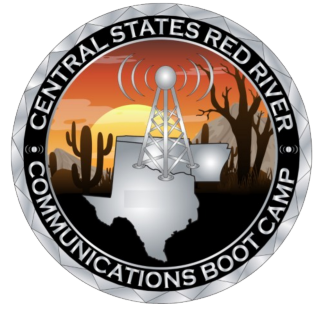
- Use proper radio discipline. Keep transmissions brief and clear.

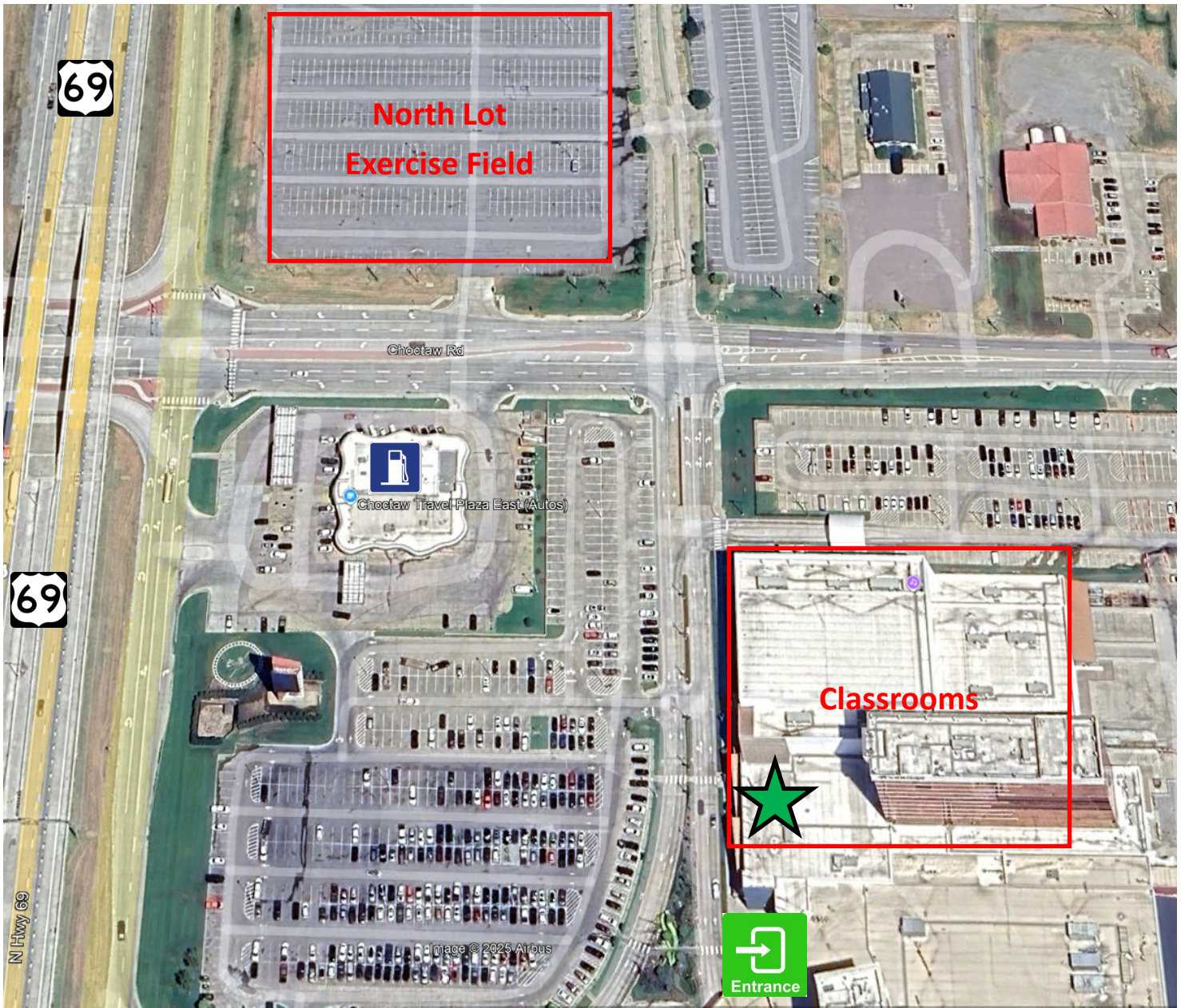

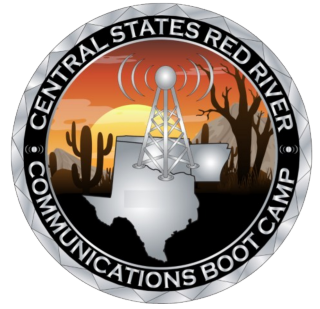


Exterior Map

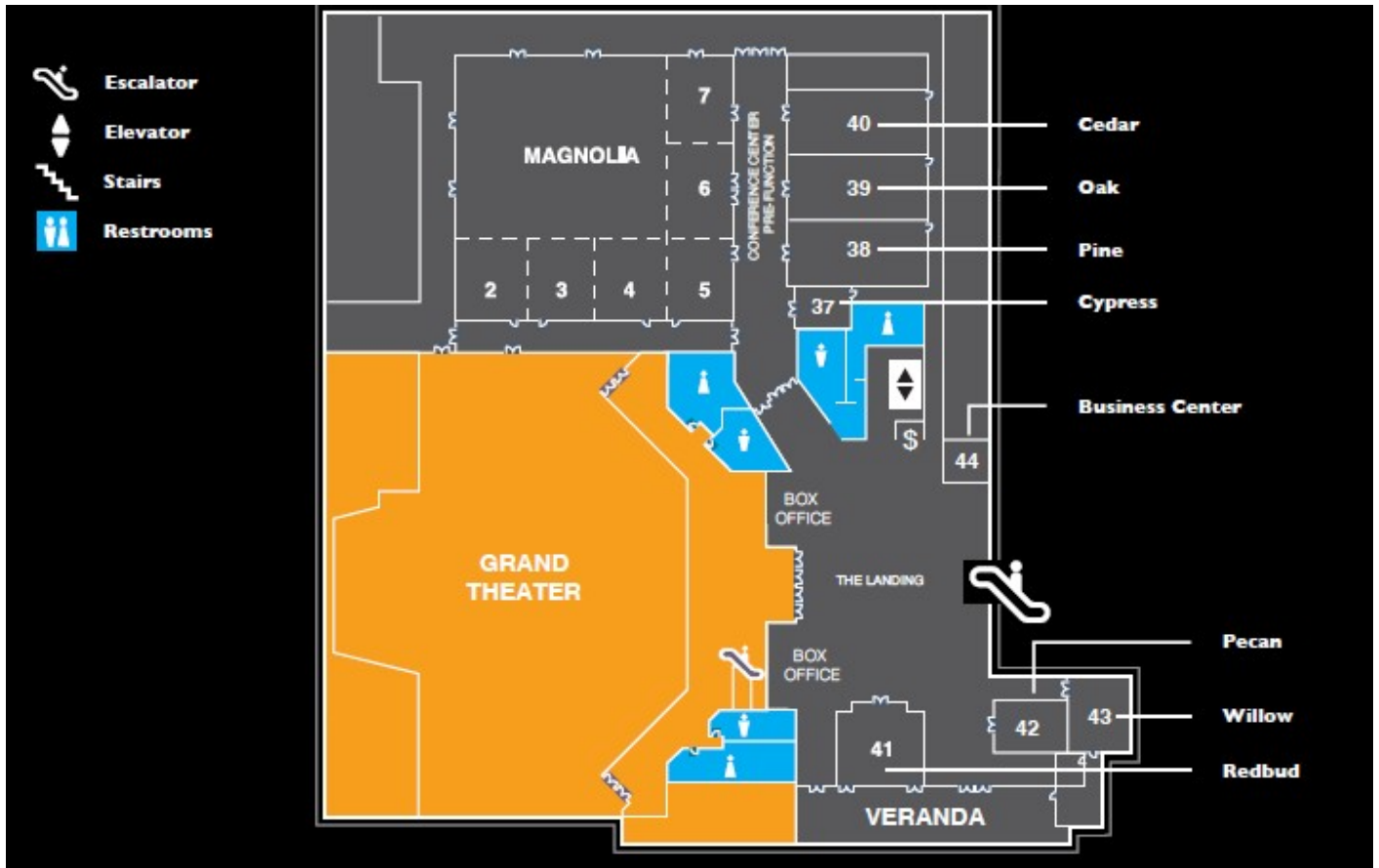
